## 2024- SEASON 2

Published in 2007, Lisa Genova's New York Times bestselling novel, *STILL ALICE*, tells the story of Alice Howland, a 50-year-old woman who is a cognitive psychology professor at Harvard University and a world-renowned linguis-

Alan Burrows ty and a world-renowned linguistics expert. She is married to an equally successful husband, and they have two grown children. When Alice notices a forgetfulness creeping into her life, confusion clouding her thinking and becoming increasingly disoriented and forgetful, a tragic diagnosis changes her life and her relationship with her family and the world.

From the novel, *STILL ALICE* was then adapted by Christine Mary Dunford into a play. This play premiered in Chicago in April 2013.

In 2014 STILL ALICE was made into a movie starring **Julianne Moore** as Alice Howland and **Alec Baldwin** as her husband, John. **Julianne Moore** won the Best Actress Academy Award for her portrayal in STILL ALICE. With **Alan Burrows** at the directorial helm, this production portrays a difficult subject with humour, lightness, sensitivity and emo-

tion. His use of projection, evocative soundscape and lighting will keep you thoroughly engaged in this tale of the human condition.


This heartbreaking but hopeful play provides the audience with an extraordinary window into the experience of living with dementia – it packs a powerful emotional punch.

#### **TOURS OF THE THEATRE**

To impart the fascinating history of this 135 year old building to interested passers-by has to be the most pleasurable part of our job. We welcome everyone who enters the building with an offer of a tour of the theatre, where we convey the history of the building, the history of the theatre, Dame Nellie Melba's story in the Melba Room and a tour of the auditorium.

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**Individual tours** are available Monday, Tuesday and Fridays 10am to 2pm... just drop in.

Since we started offering **Group Tours**, many local clubs (and not so local clubs—*Probus Club Cheltenham*) have availed themselves of a tour of the theatre.

For these larger groups we take bookings. These are conducted by our very knowledgeable volunteer **Steve Nichols** who is often accompanied by his wife **Elaine**.

On group tours, Steve will convey the Mechanics Institute building's story, the story of the LATC and then he will take you behind the scenes to the prop/costume room, the Dressing & Green Rooms and finally a tour of the backstage area. This tour lasts about one hour.
